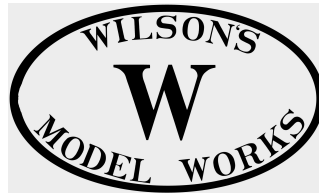

- Start with a nice even gloss coat on the whole model
- I recommend Testors gloss coat
- Cut the decal out and soak it in cool water for 10 seconds
- Larger decals can be cut into pieces as they sometime become unwieldy
- Lay the decal on a damp paper towel for 1 minute
- Coat the area to be applied with Microscale Microset
- Pull the decal off onto the model and position it with a soft paintbrush
- Correctly position the decal and let it dry thoroughly
- If any silvering occurs after drying, use a brand new hobby knife to poke tiny holes in the silvered area and apply Microscale Micro Sol
- This may need to be repeated several times
- When the decal dry, and you are happy with how the model looks, then coat the model with Testors dull coat



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
